We currently run a grocery store at 349 Victoria Road on the Southside of Glasgow, grow fruit and vegetables across three sites in and around Glasgow and provide veg boxes to over over 1300 households per week. We also supply wholesale organic groceries to progressive retailers around the UK and deliver some local produce to other shops, cafes and restaurants.

Our projects include helping new growers get started through our Grow the Growers programme and helping those facing food poverty through our Good Food Fund.

Locavore Trading started in January 2018 after we acquired Healthy Oils, an established wholesaler which had been operating since 2003. We supply a wide range of organic foods to independent retailers and caterers with around 100 customers throughout the UK.

We want to create and support short, fair and sustainable supply chains that benefit producers while helping to give independent businesses the edge to compete with supermarkets and big businesses.

We do this through focusing our core offer on affordable, good value products and by:

- Distributing foods sourced directly from organic producers using their own brand.
- Developing our own branded organic foods.
- Being a wholesaler for other brands such as Equal Exchange, Bio-D, Yogi Tea, Karma Cola and Almighty Foods.

About the post:

The post holder will join two years into the launch of the service at a time when we are looking to develop and expand considerably. You will be the only member of the team but will work closely with the Managing Director and Support Team on development aspects of the role as well as our warehouse on a daily basis.

The post will be predominately administrative with key daily tasks including:

- Taking and processing orders by phone and email.
- Managing stock levels and placing orders.
- Coordination inbound/outbound deliveries with the warehouse and hauliers.
- Assisting customers with queries.
- Simple bookkeeping tasks.

Other tasks will include:

- Writing copy for newsletters, website and brochures.
- Activities to increase sales including email/phone contact with customers and undertaking promotional activities.
- Support sales of Trading lines within our own outlets.
- Assist with other tasks as required.

There will be opportunities for the role to be developed and shaped over time as the business grows.

Required Criteria:

- Able to work well on own initiative with minimal supervision.
- Good written and verbal communication skills and a head for numbers.
- A good grasp of Excel and a high standard of general IT skills.
- An interest in organic food and the aims of Locavore.
- Ability to prioritise, adapt and and plan own workload around changing external variables.

Desirable criteria wish list:

- An advanced level of competence in Excel.
- Other IT skills such as Python or Adobe suit.
- Experience of face to face sales or product promotion.
- Experience developing new products or services.
- Experience of a similar role, related sector or comparable organisation.
